If you are a student interested in transferring to St. Joseph's College, this booklet is designed to provide answers to the many questions you may ask yourself regarding SJC's transfer policy, and to present some general information about the college itself. We recognize the need for clarifying and simplifying the transfer process, so we encourage students to learn about the process and meet with a counselor as early as possible. Let this booklet help you plan an academic program that will enable you to transfer credits with confidence.

### **How to go about transferring to St. Joseph's College:**

Any student wishing to transfer to SJC must first submit the following materials before he/she can be reviewed for acceptance:

1. Completed application, accompanied by a \$25 application fee and a list of courses in progress.
2. Official transcript(s) from college(s) attended, 2-year or other, sent directly from the institution to St. Joseph's College. (This includes college courses taken while in high school.)
3. Immunization records, including 2 MMR inoculations.
4. **For students transferring with less than 40 credits:** An official transcript from a secondary school (including SAT scores for students who graduated high school within 5 years of application) or official copy of GED.

Subsequent to your evaluation, you will be notified as to the admissions decision. Accepted students must meet with an Admissions Counselor at St. Joseph's for their evaluation interview, at which time transfer credits will be explained to the student and graduation requirements will be reviewed.

### **Graduation requirements for SJC:**

Every student seeking a B.A. or a B.S. Degree from St. Joseph's must complete 128 credits, which includes a core curriculum, a major field of study, and electives. The core curriculum is designed to acquaint you with the areas of human knowledge and culture which are essential for a liberal education. In order for your educational background to contain breadth and balance, the core is divided into 4 or 5 categories (depending on the student's major) with several areas of study.

### **Choosing Courses to Take at Your Present School That Will Transfer Easily to St. Joseph's College:**

This transfer guide is designed to help you choose courses at your current institution that will be utilized in your program of choice at St. Joseph's College. St. Joseph's cannot guarantee that it will transfer all or most of the credits earned as part of an Associate's Degree. Always confer with an advisor at the school you are attending, and also a counselor from St. Joseph's before you sign up for courses each semester. The next few pages should offer you some additional guidance by listing SJC course equivalencies at Farmingdale State University of New York, Nassau Community College, and Suffolk County Community College. In planning your program, try to take the courses that will fulfill the Core Curriculum requirements (either the general core curriculum or Child Study core, depending on your major) and/or those that have direct equivalents in your intended major at St. Joseph's. Consequently, you are insured the maximum transferability of credits. **NOTE: St. Joseph's will accept a maximum of 64 transferable credits from lower division schools (Associate's granting programs), and a maximum of 96 total credits from a combination of 2-year and 4-year schools (up to 64 credits may be from a 2-year school), in accordance with the minimum grade policy of St. Joseph's College. All students must complete a minimum of 48 credits at St. Joseph's College in order to receive a degree.**

### **Scholarships for Transfers:**

Transfer scholarships are awarded to individuals who meet the following criteria:

1. A completed Associate's Degree\* (45 transferable credits must be taken at the college awarding the A.A. or A.A.S. Degree)
2. Student must enroll full-time
3. Student must transfer a **minimum** of 60-a **maximum** of 76 credits (Combined from credits taken at a 2-year and 4-year school)
4. Student must be a direct transfer to St. Joseph's College from the school granting the Associate's Degree

***A student fulfilling the above requirements with a 3.3 to 3.5 cumulative average can be awarded up to \*\$1500 per year for two years at St. Joseph's. A student fulfilling the above requirements with a 3.6 or better cumulative average can be awarded up to a \*\$3000 per year for two years at St. Joseph's.***
